

How to make a self-portrait


Step 1 Face



Draw a small dot in the middle top part of your page and one close to the bottom.




Draw a wide, curved line joining the top dot to the bottom dot on both sides, to create the face (remember to press down very lightly in pencil in case you make a mistake).




Working **VERY LIGHTLY** in pencil draw a vertical (top to bottom) guideline down the middle of your face and two horizontal lines (left to right), roughly 2 or 3 cm apart through the middle.


Step 2 Eyes




Draw a sad smile/half oval from the top outline.



Draw an upward facing smile along the bottom guideline to join up with the top of the eye.



Draw a large circle from the top of the eye to the bottom - this will be the coloured part of the eye (the iris).



Draw two large, dark circles inside of each iris (these will be the pupils).
