How To Make A Self Portrait Using **Printmaking**


Materials

Apron/old clothes X1 Paper plate Poster or acrylic paints Assorted paintbrushes Container of water PVA glue String/wool/thread X2 small, halved potatoes

Or you could add string for hair and paint around the edges of your plate...



Instructions

- 1. Paint one flat half of your potato in a chosen colour for your eyes.
- 2. Gently press the painted side of the potato onto the top of your plate twice to create two eyes.
- 3. Paint a new potato half in your chosen colour and gently press it under the eyes to create a nose.
- 4. Paint a small black circle inside of both eyes for the pupil (using a brush or finger printing).
- 5. Dip the top of a straw in black paint and print above the eyes to create lashes or paint/fingerprint small lines.
- 6. Rip/cut two pieces of recyled/coloured paper and glue above the eyes to create eyebrows.
- 4. Paint a mouth shape under your nose using PVA glue.
- 5. Stick pieces of dry pasta/string over your PVA glue to create lips.
- 6. Apply PVA glue along the top of the plate for hair.
- 7. Stick lentils/pasta/string over the PVA glue (think about what would look most like your hair).
- 8. Paint the plate in a colour to match your skintone (optional).
- 9. Paint over your hair once the glue has dried (optional).
