How To Create Outfits For Paper Dolls Using Wet Painting and Tissue-Paper Staining.

Materials

Jar/container of water

Paper dolls/watercolour paper

Watercolour paints

Paintbrushes

Apron

Table covering/newspaper



Colourful tissue paper

Pinch of table salt (optional)

Water Spray (optional)



Wet Painting Using Watercolours

Paint your template with water.



Drop some watercolours onto your wet template (using a brush or your finger) and watch the colours spread out and bleed.



Add some more colours....



EXTRA: Add a pinch of salt to your wet paints and watch new patterns form...

Colour Staining with Tissue-paper.

1.



Cut/tear some colourful pieces of tissue paper and cover your template with them.

2.



Gently spary/paint over your tissue paper with water.

3.



Leave your artwork to dry for 20 minutes (and make a few different colour versions whilst you wait).



Remove the wet tissue-paper and see what patterns have been created.
