Mosaic Design for Health & Wellbeing (ALDD)

Thursdays, 11am-1pm | 10 weeks | Non-accredited | £105 full cost / £45 / £5 if on certain benefits

This is a weekly session designed specifically for adults with learning difficulties and/or disabilities. Participants design and make mosaic artworks both individually and as a group, involving cutting, laying and grouting tiles. It provides a great source of interaction and wellbeing, as well as developing skills such as dexterity.




This is a mixed ability course and adults with no specific learning needs are welcome to join.

- gained an understanding of basic art and design principles
- used cutting tools safely
- used a variety of mosaics and alternative materials
- created a mosaic panel
- contributed towards making a large mosaic panel



Led by professional artists, students will learn painting, drawing, collage and printmaking and work towards individual and group final pieces.

By the end of the course you will know how to:

- select and blend paints
- apply collage techniques to various surfaces
- use printmaking tools and apply inks/paints to canvas
- work collaboratively on joint projects
- use a variety of dry media


